PATIENCE

Patience is a virtue that is often tested in our daily lives. Whether it be waiting in line at the grocery store, dealing with difficult coworkers, or facing challenging circumstances, patience is a quality that is essential for our growth as individuals. In the Bible, God frequently calls on us to practice patience in various situations.

The first verse that comes to mind is found in James 5:7-8, which says, “Be patient, then, brothers and sisters, until the Lord’s coming. See how the farmer waits for the land to yield its valuable crop, patiently waiting for the autumn and spring rains. You too, be patient and stand firm, because the Lord’s coming is near.” Just as a farmer must wait patiently for the harvest, we also must wait for the fulfillment of God’s promises in our lives. It can be easy to become discouraged or impatient when we don’t see immediate results, but God calls on us to trust in

His timing and remain committed in our faith.

Another verse that shows the importance of patience is Romans 12:12, “Be joyful in hope, patient in affliction, faithful in prayer.” This verse emphasizes the need for patience, especially during times of trial and difficulty. It can be very hard to remain patient going through hardships and obstacles, but God reminds us to hold onto hope, remain firm in our faith, and trust that He will see us through. By doing this, we grow stronger in our faith and develop a deeper reliance on God’s guidance.

Lastly, Philippians 4:6-7 encourages us to “be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and

supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.” What a powerful reminder when we feel anxious or impatient, we can turn to God in prayer and trust that He will provide us with the peace and comfort that we need. By surrendering our worries and concerns to God and seeking His guidance, we can develop a spirit of patience.

When God asks for patience, He’s inviting us to trust in His timing, remain firm in our faith, and seek His guidance in all circumstances. By practicing patience in our daily lives, we can grow closer to God, deepen our faith, and experience His peace and comfort during trials and life’s storms. **END**



MORE ON PATIENCE

Dictionary.com defines patience as “an ability or willingness to suppress restlessness or annoyance when confronted with delay.” A wise individual once said, “Patience is not the ability to wait but the ability to keep a good attitude while waiting.” When I came across this quote this past week, a few thoughts came to mind on how this definition applies to our individual relationship with God. My initial thoughts go to the incredible amount of patience our Lord shows with us through all of our flaws and shortcomings. 1 Peter 2:20 says, “²⁰ For what credit is it if, when you are beaten for your faults, you take it patiently? But when you do good and suffer, if you take it patiently, this is commendable before God.” This scripture reminds us that no matter what we go through, how we handle it, is pretty important to our Lord. How about it? Are we practicing Godly patience in our lives?

James 1:2-4 states, “² My brethren, count it all joy when you fall into various trials, ³ knowing that the testing of your faith produces patience. ⁴ But let patience have its perfect work, that you may be perfect[mature] and complete, lacking nothing. “ There is no doubt that we all face tests daily. But the more we can live by the definition of patience and God’s example, the stronger our relationship with him can become.

When things don’t happen on our time or the way we envision, how do we react? Psalm 37:7-8 reads, “⁷ Rest in the Lord, and wait patiently for Him; do not fret because of him who prospers in his way, because of the man who brings wicked schemes to pass. ⁸ Cease from anger, and
