STANDING ON THE PROMISES - PART TWO

Last week, one of the songs we sang was "Standing On The Promises" so, I thought I'd write a little about what this means for us as Christians. We could say that we're actually standing upon God's faithfulness for 2 Peter 1:3.4 reminds us, "³ Seeing that His divine power has granted to us everything pertaining to life and godliness, through the true knowledge of Him who called us by His own glory and excellence. ⁴ For by these *He has granted to us His precious and magnificent promises*, so that by them you may become partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world by lust." [emphasis mine]. So, last week we looked at the biblical definition of what a promise is. The New Testament word is *epaggelia* (eh-PAWG-gah-Lee-ah); It means an announcement (for information, assent, or pledge; especially a divine assurance of good). In Biblical usage, a "promise" contains the elements of covenant, contract, and pledge, with blessings in store to the beneficiary. In a sense, a promise is a prophecy, the fulfill-[continued on page 2]

[continued from front] ment of which is to be expected.

Next, let's look at THE VALUE OF A PROMISE: We are called upon to believe promises every day. Car salesmen make promises, teachers make promises; our political leaders make promises; your spouse and children make promises; how many of these promises do you believe? Maybe not all of them? Why not and why then should we believe the promises of God?

The value of a promise to be believed is based on three things: 1) the integrity of the one who promises; 2) the ability of the one who promises to keep the promise; and 3) the past record of the one who promises. Let's look at each of these:



1. The integrity of the one who promised:
How does God rate here?
It is the absolute integrity of God that is the as-

surance of His promises. The scriptures consistently argue for the trustworthiness of God:

"God is faithful, by whom you were called into [continued on page 3]

the fellowship of His Son, Jesus Christ our Lord" (1 Corinthians. 1:9); "He who calls you is faithful, who also will do it" (1 Thessalonians 5:24); "But the Lord is faithful, who will establish you and guard you from the evil one" (2 Thessalonians 3:3); "If we are faithless, He remains faithful; He cannot deny Himself." (2 Timothy 2:13).

The Hebrew writer calls on Christians to lay hold on the hope presented to them in the counsel of God because it is impossible for God to lie. (Hebrews 6:13-20 — It's there, I promise... look it up when you have the opportunity!)



2. The ability of the one who promises: I may make you a promise and you might be inclined to believe it because you believe that I'm an honest

person. But if it is something I cannot control, then I may have to break my promise. For instance, a grandfather may make a promise to his grandchildren to go fishing when they next come visit, but then it rains or the wind blows, and the promise has to be broken (There's a lesson about making promises here but that's for another time). God is not hampered in the fulfillment of His promises. He is omnipotent:

When God revealed himself to the patriarchs and made promises on which they were to trust, He made Himself known as "El Shaddai" (God Almighty). When God appeared to Abram to reaffirm the promise of a son in his old age, He came to Abram and said, "I am God Almighty [El Shaddai]; walk before Me, and be blameless (Genesis 17:1). The promise was assured because God was Almighty. Again, the scriptures show God's mighty power:

"Ah, Lord God! Behold, You have made the heavens and the earth by Your great power and outstretched arm. There is nothing too hard for You. (Jeremiah 32:17); "For nothing will be impossible with God." (Luke 1:37).

The promises of the New Testament were confirmed in the power of the resurrection – Acts 17:31 says, "because He has appointed a day on which He will judge the world in righteousness by the Man whom He has ordained. He has given assurance of this to all by raising Him from the dead."



3. The past record of the One who has promised: We hear and receive promises all the

time! I'll pay you back next month; I'll never hit you again; I won't raise your taxes; etc. But has God ever failed to keep His promises? The unequivocal answer to that question is, "NO!" This absolute constancy and fidelity is often referred to in scripture as God's faithfulness: "Therefore know that the Lord your God, He is God, the faithful God who keeps covenant and mercy for a thousand generations with those who love Him and keep His commandments" (Deuteronomy 7:9)

The International Standard Bible Encyclopedia (ISBE) points out that this characteristic is one aspect of His truth and unchangeableness." God is true not only because He is really God in contrast to all that is not God, and because He realizes the idea of Godhead, but also because He is constant or faithful in keeping His promises, and therefore is worthy of trust. The scripture often connects this unchangeableness with God's goodness and mercy and also with His constancy in reference to His covenant promises, and this is what the Old Testament means by the Faithfulness of God.

Often the Old Testament scriptures use the term "rock" to refer to this character trait, as it is His faithfulness to His words that provide true security for His people. Psalm 18:2 tells us, "The Lord is my rock and my fortress and my deliverer; [continued on page 6]

ACTS 20:7-12 — EUTYCHUS RAISED

⁷ On the first day of the week we came together to break bread. Paul spoke to the people and, because he intended to leave the next day, kept on talking until midnight. 8 There were many lamps in the upstairs room where we were meeting. 9 Seated in a window was a young man named Eutychus, who was sinking into a deep sleep as Paul talked on and on. When he was sound asleep, he fell to the ground from the third story and was picked up dead. 10 Paul went down, threw himself on the young man and put his arms around him. "Don't be alarmed," he said. "He's alive!" 11 Then he went upstairs again and broke bread and ate. After talking until daylight, he left. 12 The people took the young man home alive and were greatly comforted.
