THE CONDITION VERSUS THE PLAN OF SALVATION

I have long believed as many of you that perhaps we need to revise our way of teaching about salvation. If you've been in the church for any amount of time, whenever the topic was "The Plan of Salvation," you could almost guarantee that the sermon points would be: 1) Hear, 2) Believe, 3) Repent, 4) Confess, and 5) Be baptized. But is that really the PLAN of salvation?

Before I go any further, I'd like to say for the record that the five-point outline above is perfectly Scriptural! That is EXACTLY what we must do to be saved (cf. Romans 10:17; Acts 2:38; Acts 8:35-38). So, this article is NOT about removing those essential duties from our Christian walk! These things must be taught to every sinner who will listen. I may be playing with semantics but the point I want to make is that these five points are NOT the PLAN of salvation! Instead, these five things are the CONDITIONS of salvation for the alien sinner.



When we call those five things “the plan of salvation,” we have left out of lot of necessary information – and we’ve misrepresented the true plan of salvation! Will you open your mind and think with me about this?

If I may just get to the point, “The PLAN of Salvation” is Jesus on the cross! Note: “For the message of the CROSS is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being SAVED it is the power of God;” then later, it says, “it pleased God through the foolishness of the message preached to SAVE those who believe” (1Corinthians 1:18,21). In other words: without Christ, without the cross, without the shedding of His blood, the five conditions of salvation would be powerless to save anyone! When we stress the conditions, without mentioning their connection to the cross, it should not surprise us when some accuse us of trying to “earn” our salvation by works – because that’s exactly what it sounds like! Keep in mind that I’m talking about others’ perceptions of what we say. So, if I may be so bold, I would like to suggest a better outline for teaching sinners about salvation:

- I. The NEED of salvation because of sin
 - a. The DEFINITION of sin – transgression of God’s law, by commission or omission (1 John 5:17; James 4:17)
 - b. The CAUSE of sin – it is NOT an inherited trait, but a deliberate choice



- to do evil (Ezekiel 18:20; James 1:13-15)
- c. The EXTENT of sin – EVERYONE becomes guilty of sin at some point in their lives (Romans 3:23; 1 John 1:8)
- d. The RESULT of sin – sin results in eternal “death” (note the contrast with “eternal life,” Romans 6:23)

II. The PLAN of salvation (Christ)

- a. God provided a sacrificial lamb as a substitute for our punishment (cf. John 1:29)
- b. The life (blood) of Christ was the ransom price paid to free us from sin (Matthew 20:28)

c. If it were not for the shedding of His blood, there would be NO salvation! (cf. Hebrews 9:22)

- d. His selfless sacrifice is designed to “compel” repentance and faithfulness (2 Corinthians 5:14-15)

III. The CONDITIONS of salvation

- a. Hear and believe in Christ (John 8:24; Romans 10:17)
- b. Repentance of all our sins (Luke 13:3,5)
- c. Confession of our faith in Christ (Acts 8:37)
- d. Baptism for the remission of sins (Acts 2:38-39)

IV. The RESULT of salvation (church)

- a. Those meeting the conditions of salvation are added to God’s church (Acts 2:38,41,47)

- b. As God's people, the church has one mission: to glorify God (Ephesians 3:20-21; 1 Timothy 3:14-15)
- c. We glorify God by doing what HE says, rather than doing what WE want (Matthew 5:16)
- d. This would include working with other saved people in a local church (Hebrews 10:24-25)

Now, I realize that the above outline can certainly be improved upon. But don't you think it's a much more comprehensive treatment of the plan of salvation, rather than just looking at the conditions of salvation? So, the next time someone asks you about the plan of salvation, why don't we tell them the WHOLE story! **END**
