GOD'S GRACE: ALWAYS UNMERITED, NOT EVER UNCONDITIONAL

One of the most marvelous themes in all the Bible is the grace of God. Scripture affirms repeatedly that God's grace is undeserved, unearned, and unmerited. Paul declares, "8 For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, 9 not of works, lest anyone should boast." (Ephesians 2:8-9).

No one can stand before God and boast that they have obligated the Almighty to usher them into Heaven by his/her own righteousness. As sinners, we stand in need of grace we can never earn (Romans 3:23-24 – "23 for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, 24 being justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus").

Yet, while God's grace is always unmerited, it is not always unconditional. This is a point often overlooked in modern religious thinking. Some imagine that grace is poured out indiscriminately, without regard to man's or woman's response. But the Bible shows that observing God's conditions (aka rules) are connected with receiving His blessings. Grace remains free – but it must be received on God's terms.

Consider Noah. In Genesis 6:5-7, we read of God's displeasure with mankind with the world's overwhelming wickedness. But as God pronounces judgment,

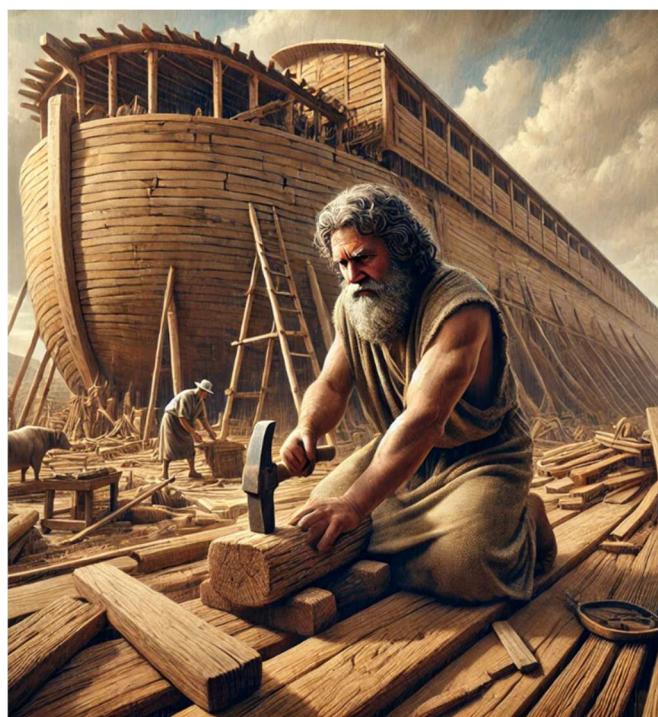

ment upon the world and prepares to destroy the earth with a flood, we find one of the most encouraging statements in scripture: "But Noah found grace in the eyes of the Lord." That grace was clearly undeserved – Noah was not sinless. But he stood in contrast to the people of the world whose "every intent of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually." (6:5). Noah, on the other hand, was a "just [righteous] man, perfect [blameless] in his generations." (6:9).

Even so, God's gracious provision of salvation through the ark required Noah's obedient response. "22 Thus Noah did; according to all that God commanded him, so he did." (6:22). Some have concluded that God arbitrarily chose Noah to be saved and chose everyone else to perish. When we examine Scripture more closely, we see a different picture. Noah did not earn God's grace, but his actions before and during the flood positioned him to receive it. In contrast to the wickedness of the world around him, Noah lived differently. He wasn't sinless but he must have been a man of moral integrity – he was upright and without glaring faults, He

stood out from the corruption of his day. Genesis 6:9 states that "Noah walked with God." This was the true demonstration of Noah's righteousness – Noah was the same as his great grandfather Enoch who also walked with God (Genesis 5:24).

The New Testament presents the same balance. James writes, "He gives more grace," but immediately adds, "God resists the proud, but gives grace to the humble" (James 4:6). This is not to say that the humble are earning grace, any more than any of us earn God's grace, but their disposition and actions open the door for God to bestow it more abundantly. This principle appears in 2 Peter 1:2: "Grace and peace be multiplied to you in the knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord." Notice the phrase "be multiplied" –



indicating that God's grace can increase in the life of the believer. Peter then immediately calls Christians to supply diligence, faith, virtue, knowledge, self-control, and steadfastness (vv. 5–7). As we grow in these qualities, we enjoy God's grace in fuller measure.

Noah's obedience was prompted by his faith: "By faith Noah, being divinely warned of things not yet seen, moved with godly fear, prepared an ark, for the saving of his household, by which he condemned the world and became heir of the righteousness which is according to faith" (Hebrews 11:7). Noah not only lived righteously, but he also preached righteousness; he is even described as "a preacher of righteousness." (2 Peter 2:5). Based on Genesis 6:3, he had 120 years to proclaim God's warning while the ark was being prepared. God's grace was available to all, but only Noah and his family were willing to heed the message.

How does this apply to us today? Just as Noah found grace, so can we. When we turn from sin and turn toward God, we discover the very same blessing: "grace in the eyes of the Lord." Peter draws a powerful comparison between Noah's salvation and

ours: "who formerly were disobedient, when once the Divine longsuffering waited in the days of Noah, while the ark was being prepared, in which a few, that is, eight souls, were saved through water. There is also an antitype which now saves us – baptism (not the removal of the filth of the flesh, but the answer of a good conscience toward God), through the resurrection of Jesus Christ" (1 Peter 3:20-21).

Just as God used water to save Noah from a sinful world, today through God's grace, He uses the waters of baptism to bring us into a new life through the blood of Jesus! Noah's story is one of grace offered, faith displayed, and obedience rewarded. The same God who saved Noah is still offering grace to all who will listen, believe, and obey.

We must therefore avoid two extremes: (1) Thinking we can earn God's grace – we cannot and (2) Assuming God always gives grace without conditions – He does not. Yes, grace remains the free gift of a loving God, but it is a gift received through humble obedience by faith (Hebrews 5:9). **END**
