COMMENTS ON HEBREWS 2:2

Our Scripture Word Search of Hebrews 2:1-4 gives us the first of several earnest cautions because the people of a Hebrew background were reverting to temple sacrifices and other practices of Judaism. The entire book warns about the issue of allowing the truth of New Testament truth to slip away. There are five warnings in five separate places. The first warning found in the verses under consideration is the shortest of them all. They are:

- First Warning: Hebrews 2:1-5
- Second Warning: Hebrews 3:7-4:13
- Third Warning: Hebrews 6:4-8
- Fourth Warning: Hebrews 10:26-39
- Fifth Warning: Hebrews 12:25-29

These first four verses make a shift from teaching (didactic) to exhortation as the writer – who includes himself in these verses – states in Hebrews 13:22. So, now the book of [continued on page 3]

Hebrews turns to its intended audience – it will NOT allow the truth to remain unexamined in the believer's life.

For the purpose of this article, I'd like to concentrate on verse two of chapter two of Hebrews.

We start off with these words: "For if [and it is true] the word spoken through angels..." The "if" here indicates that the word spoken through angels was true; it can be counted upon. When they as its agents revealed Scripture, it was the authoritative and accurate revelation from God's viewpoint. The "word spoken through angels" was when God gave the Law at Sinai (Deuteronomy 33:2; Psalm 68:17; Acts 7:53; Galatians 3:19). God gave the Law to the Israelites in order to define the conditions of blessings obtained from obedience and curses for disobedience.

The next part of verse two says, "... proved steadfast [binding]..." The word "steadfast" throughout the book of Hebrews expresses something that is sure; it is certain. In biblical par-

lance, truth is something that is fixed (Hebrews 3:6, 14; 6:19; 9:17). So, the word "steadfast" means binding or firm; God's word is unyielding. The word that God revealed through His angels was binding – that is, legally valid. And His word has eternal validity; He does not change that which He has revealed. When God our Father speaks, it is ALWAYS legally valid. Revelation in the Old Testament was binding in the sense that it's unchangeable because the revelation was spoken by God Himself.

Verse 2c tells us, "... and every transgression and disobedience..." These two words, "transgressions" and "disobedience" refer to complete disregard of God's revelation. "Transgression" means to violate a clear standard of Scripture. It carries the idea of stepping over the "line drawn in the sand." The word "disobedience" means to refuse to take to heart what God has said: it is to neglect to do what the Law required. Both of these terms are explicit RE-JECTION of God's will as revealed in His word.

2d states, "... received a just reward [retribution, penalty]..." The Law under Moses prescribed a penalty for those who violated or transgressed It. I'm not sure that the "just" retribution refers to salvation of the soul; it seems to point more toward the loss of blessing for the nation of Israel. "Reward" or retribution or penalty seems to relate to the loss of inheritance. We know that God NEVER takes sin lightly; He always specifies the appropriate action for any infringement of His word. Since the first chapter of Hebrews argues for the deliverance that Jesus provides, it seems at least possible that some believers will lose part of all of their inheritance. We know that Hebrews was written to believers as evidenced by the following Scripture:

- "Holy Brothers" (3:1)
- "Brethren" (3:1, 12)
- "Share [partake] in the heavenly calling" (3:1)
- "God's house" (3:6)
- "Share in Christ" (3:14)
- "Ought to be teachers (5:12)
- "Tasted of the heavenly gift" (6:4)

RELIABLE

As members of the local church, we are sheep who make up the flock (Acts 20:28). We are at the same time servants of Christ (Acts 4:29). We must ask ourselves, "Can the Lord depend on me?" Can He depend on me to be present at feeding time (every service and Bible class)? Can He depend on me to stand up for His truth when it is under attack? Can He depend on me to give as He has made me prosper?" Remember that it was Jesus who asked, "Why do you call me, 'Lord, Lord,' and do not do what I say? (Luke 6:46). He is relying on all of us to be about His business.

Remember that David described himself and his fellow Israelites as "... his people, the sheep of his pasture" (Psalm 100:3). In other words, they belonged to God and were to serve according to the pleasure of His will. The people in Ezra 5:11 identified themselves as "...the servants of the God of heaven and earth..." (Ezra 5:11). They were determined not to let anyone or anything stop them from finishing their God-appointed tasks in rebuilding the Temple.

Jesus used the analogy of sheep to represent his disciples. He said that His sheep (followers) would hear His voice and follow Him (John 10:3, 16, 27). Later, when Peter answered the council's command for the apostles to stop preaching in the name of Jesus, he said, "... Which is right in God's eyes: to listen to you, or to him? ... (Acts 4:19-20). Peter was determined to follow the instructions of the Chief Shepherd (1 Peter 5:4).

It is probably sound advice that, when a car leaves you stranded, you should return the favor. Few people would keep a car that cannot be depended upon to work as needed. There may be a parable here.

So, it seems that it is possible to lose the re-

ward of our inheritance but the "reward" or retribution or penalty in this passage may not be talking about loss of salvation but loss of inheritance, but only if "salvation" and "inheritance" mean two different things. There are indications that a believer cannot lose their salvation (John 10:28-29; Ephesians 1:11-14; 1 Peter 1:3-5), just as there are indications that the believer CAN lose that salvation (John 15:5-6; Hebrews 6:4-8; 10:19-39; 1 Timothy 1:18-20;). I will admit that I am not smart enough to reconcile this particular (human) conundrum; instead I will rely on God's grace and the blood of Jesus and my own obedience to ensure I make it to heaven! How about you?

SELECTED VERSES FROM HEBREWS

Hebrews 10:1-7 — ¹ The law is only a shadow of the good things that are coming—not the realities themselves. For this reason it can never, by the same sacrifices repeated endlessly year after year, make perfect those who draw near to worship. ² Otherwise, would they not have stopped being offered? For the worshipers would have been cleansed once for all, and would no longer have felt guilty for their sins. ³ But those sacrifices are an annual reminder of sins. ⁴ It is impossible for the blood of bulls and goats to take away sins.

⁵ Therefore, when Christ came into the world, he said: "Sacrifice and offering you did not desire, but a body you prepared for me; ⁶ with burnt offerings and sin offerings you were not pleased. ⁷ Then I said, 'Here I am — it is written about me in the scroll — I have come to do your will, my God.'"

Hebrews 11:1-3 - Now faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see. ² This is what the ancients were commended for. ³ By faith we understand that the universe was formed at God's command, so that what is seen was not made out of what was visible.
