A NEW YEAR, A NEW BEGINNING

This is the last Sunday of 2025 and this Thursday is day one of 2026. This marks 33 years I've worshiped with the brethren here in Lytle and 16 years since I started as a minister on January 1, 2010. I have had the privilege of writing around 700 bulletin articles.

When I was a youngster, it seemed as though a year was an interminable period of time: the school year, especially, seemed as though it would never end. Through my teenage years, time continued to drag and at eighteen it seemed as though I would never reach twenty-one, a full-fledged legal adult. Of course, that was something of a contradiction since, by the time I turned twenty-one, I had served at our country's leisure as a sailor in the U.S. Navy for two full years, working and operating in an adult world. But once I turned twenty-one the years have started to click off ever more quickly.

Anymore, the expression "time flies" seems like a gross understatement. Some of that sense of time is undoubtedly due to the continuing emphasis that our culture places upon speed – we're always seeking ways to do things faster. However, as we trim production and trim it again, we simply fill the time saved with more tasks. As we accomplish more, we're always seeking ways to accomplish more yet. It all has become a never-ending cycle that seems to wind itself around our necks in an ever tightening noose.

Time, though a constant, is moving more and more


quickly, and each passing year brings each of us closer to the day when our personal time on this earth will be over. We are, after all, simply alien ambassadors on this earth (2 Corinthians 5:20). More importantly, each day brings us closer to that day of reckoning when God will hold all mankind accountable (Romans 14:12; 1 Corinthians 5:10; James 4:17) for the way we have lived our lives and bring time, as this world knows it, to an abrupt end (Revelation 10:6 KJV).

With the progress of relentless time I've come to realize that the true basis of life does not consist in how many jobs we get done, how many promotions or accolades we accumulate, how much money we make or save or how much stuff we possess. What gives life meaning is our spiritual identity. We're created in God's image. He has prepared an eternal home for us. Getting there, and hopefully taking others with us, is what life is all about. earth is tied to our getting home there. Teaching others this truth is part of our service to God as we travel through the time He has given us. And the devil has been very good at getting people to focus only on this life and away from God.
