POOR RELIGIOUS LEADERS & THEIR THREE GREATEST DESIRES

There are three desires that bad religious leaders have: (1) attention, (2) position and (3) possessions. We need to beware of people who have an inordinate desire of these things. In start contrast, we need to behold Jesus Christ – the ultimate religious leader.

The first desire of a bad religious leader is ATTENTION. In his teaching, Jesus said, "Beware of the scribes, who like to walk around in long robes and like greetings in the marketplaces. . ." (Mark 12:38).

The scribes of first century Israel were the religious experts in Old Testament Law. They hand-copied it, memorized it, taught it, wrote about it, and settled disputes about it. They were sort of like a cross between a Seminary professor and a Bible commentary writer. Beyond that, they functioned as lawyers and governing leaders. So, why would [continued on page 3]

Jesus tell us to beware of them?

First off, Jesus says that the scribes "like to walk around in long robes." Scribes would wear certain robes when they did their work. They wore special robes reserved for top-tier, elite people. But there were two problems with the way the scribes related to their robes:

1. They LIKED to walk around in their robes. The scribes loved to walk around in their robes and be seen in said robes. That was their desire.

2. They liked to WALK AROUND in their robes. This, in my mind, indicates that they just weren't wear-

ing their robes for their work; their scribal duties. It's quite possible they were walking around town in their fancy robes so that the people would see them and give them the attention they craved — as it says, "greetings in the marketplaces." The scribes liked getting attention — not necessarily honoring God and serving the people.

The second desire of a bad religious leader is **POSITION.** Jesus tells us to beware of the scribes, who "have the best seats in the synagogues and the places of honor at feasts . . ." (Mark 12:39).

Seating then and now is a clear indicator of social status in ours and theirs cultures. In the first century, the best seats, the most important seats were those that were closest to the front and higher than the rest. Similarly, at feasts, there were specific places of honor and the scribes, being so important (at least in their minds), enjoyed this prominent seating

Jesus, of course, sees right through the scribes. He knows they don't care to honor God and serve the people in their roles — they wanted attention and position.

The third desire of a bad religious leader is POSSESSIONS. Here Jesus warns to beware of the scribes "who devour widows' houses and for a pretense make long prayers." (Mark 12:40a). So, Jesus points out that the scribes like possessions and verse 40 conjures vivid imagery in our minds, describing them eating up the resources of widows — one of the most vulnerable groups of peo-

ple. They were using their position to take advantage of others.

Then to cover over their true character, they worded pretend prayers. They didn't like honoring God and serving people — they liked possessions, even going so far as to use people to their own advantage.

Jesus' conclusion couldn't be clearer when he states at the end of verse 40b: "They will receive the greater condemnation."

Brethren, we all desire attention, position and possessions. Yes, we've been forgiven and transformed by Jesus Christ, but our remnant sinnature still clings to us as closely as a speed skater's skin-tight uniform. Everyone of us has sinful desires: we all desire to have attention, be in the best position and have more possessions so, yes, religious leaders are not the only ones.

But in light of what Jesus is teaching here, we need to hold each other and our religious leaders accountable. We have to be watchful because we don't want to follow a religious leader whose primary desires are for attention, position and possessions because if they go off track, so will we.

A more prime application of all this is regarding religious leaders that we don't know personally. There are religious leaders on television, radio, podcasts and bookstores — so many ways for us to be influenced by preachers whom we'll never meet. And we need to watch out for them. need to beware of those people who show signs of an inordinate desire for attention, position and possessions.

We, all, must beware of bad religious leaders, but on a more positive note, Thank God — behold Jesus Christ — the ultimate religious leader! He is nothing like the scribes!

First, Jesus did not desire attention. Isaiah says of him, "he had no form or majesty that we should look at him, and no beauty that we should desire him" (Isaiah 53:2). In other words, Jesus didn't come in a robe of "look at me; I'm important." He came in humble appearance, giving attention to the people He was serving.

Second, Jesus did not desire position. Paul tells us that Jesus, "who, though he was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, but emptied himself, by taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men" (Philippians 2:6-7). Jesus didn't desire position — he gave it away. He gave up his position so that he could lift us up!

Third, Jesus did not desire possessions. Luke recounts that Jesus said, "Foxes have holes, and birds of the air have nests, but the Son of Man has nowhere to lay his head" (Luke 9:58).

So, brethren, let's follow Jesus. Let's follow religious leaders who are like Jesus. And let's try our best to become like Jesus!

¹ In the meantime, when an innumerable multitude of people had gathered together, so that they trampled one another, He began to say to His disciples first of all, "Beware of the leaven of the Pharisees, which is hypocrisy. ² For there is nothing covered that will not be revealed, nor hidden that will not be known. ³ Therefore whatever you have spoken in the dark will be heard in the light, and what you have spoken in the ear in inner rooms will be proclaimed on the housetops." − Luke 12:1-3

VARIOUS VERSES FROM MARK

Mark 7:1-7 — ¹ Then the Pharisees and some of the scribes came together to Him, having come from Jerusalem. ² Now when they saw some of His disciples eat bread with defiled, that is, with unwashed hands, they found fault. ³ For the Pharisees and all the Jews do not eat unless they wash their hands in a special way, holding the tradition of the elders. ⁴ When they come from the marketplace, they do not eat unless they wash. And there are many other things which they have received and hold, like the washing of cups, pitchers, copper vessels, and couches.

⁵ Then the Pharisees and scribes asked Him, "Why do Your disciples not walk according to the tradition of the elders, but eat bread with unwashed hands?"

⁶ He answered and said to them, "Well did Isaiah prophesy of you hypocrites, as it is written: 'This people honors Me with their lips, but their heart is far from Me. ⁷ And in vain they worship Me, teaching as doctrines the commandments of men.'
