NO PILLOW SO SOFT

There are many proverbs from many lands that talk about man's conscience: "The best asset is a clear conscience" (Polish Proverb). "No one else can represent your conscience" (Native American Proverb attributed to the Anishinabe Tribe). "In the court room of the conscience, a case is always in progress" (Dutch Proverb). And there is an old French proverb (or German, depending upon your source) that says, "There is no pillow so soft as a clear conscience." Which means that, believe it or not, there are people whose conscience will not allow them to sleep. A sensitive conscience is God's design for man — it is one of the things that distinguishes us from God's other creatures. When we say that someone is acting like a beast, it is often in reference to the fact that his conscience has become so callous, so cruel, so hard-hearted, as to be ineffective. Examples of such are evident every night in the evening news. Man's inhumanity to man is not evidence that he has evolved from a lower form of life; it is evidence that he has, by means of a seared conscience, descended to a beastly, rotten, vile, passion-oriented existence.

The apostle Paul spoke of some who had "by means of the hypocrisy of liars seared... their own conscience as with a branding iron" (1 Timothy 4:2). He also spoke of those who had defiled both their mind and their conscience (Titus 1:15). The conscience is "the faculty of recognizing the distinction between right and wrong in regard to

own [one's] conduct" (American Heritage Dictionary of the English Language). The conscience is intended to be sensitive to its violation. However, when repeatedly offended, the conscience becomes insensitive and useless in guiding moral conduct.

"Let vour conscience be your guide" must, therefore, be taken within the scope of whether or not the conscience has been properly educated by the word of God. Otherwise, morality becomes a purely subjective matter. Before his conversion to Christ, Paul sincerely believed that he was correct in persecuting those Jews who were professing Christ Jesus. He said, "Brethren I have lived my life with a perfectly good conscience before God up to this day" (Acts 23:1). People may, in good conscience, be involved in all sorts of wicked activities. But, conscience alone is not a safe guide. For it to turn from the subjective to the objective, it must be educated by what is revealed in the word of God. Otherwise, society degenerates into moral ambiguity, each man being his own guide.

The Scripture encourages us to "keep faith and a good conscience" (1 Timothy 1:19). A defiled conscience can be cleansed by the blood of Christ so as to serve the living God (Hebrews 9:14). By means of the conversion process, as described in Scripture, we become new creatures.

> Old things pass away, and all things are made new (Romans 6:4 - "Therefore, we were buried with Him through baptism into death, that just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we. even SO should walk in newness of life."; 2 Corin-

thians 5:17 - "There-

fore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new."). There is saving power in Biblical baptism. 1 Peter 3:21 reminds us that it is "not the removal of dirt from the flesh, but an appeal to God for a good conscience – through the resurrection of Jesus Christ..." The soft pillow of a clear conscience is the result of obedience to the gospel and faithful Christian living. Therefore, we should by all means stand in the grace of God, having taken those steps that lead to a clear conscience through the blood of Christ (Romans 5:2).

GREAT NON-RESPECTOR

God doesn't do it. Preachers of the Gospel are commanded not to do it. Members of the Lord's church are warned against it. Yet, in nearly every (if NOT every) congregation it happens! What am I speaking of? Being a respecter of persons.

In the Greek, the phrase "respecter of persons" is a single compound word literally meaning, "receiving of face." In other words, how we treat an individual depends upon whose face it is. The word or phrase involves partiality and favoritism.

It is against the nature of God to be a respecter of persons. He is the almighty Creator of all humanity therefore, He treats all people in the same manner – there is no bias with Him. This is especially true in the matter of salvation. Every single human has the ability to be forgiven of their sins for all have access to the blood of Iesus through which we can be cleansed of iniquity (sin). The Jews of the first century had a difficult time with this concept. They considered themselves to be God's favorites - all non-Jews were heathens and dogs. When the Gospel began to be preached, it was clear that this concept of favoritism was false, but the Jews persisted in holding to it. Even the Apostles struggled with it. It took a vision from God and the baptism of the Holy Spirit to convince Peter that the Gentiles could become God's children (Acts 10:34-35).

God is also no respecter of persons when it comes to His judgment — He will judge ALL fairly. Our Heavenly Father doesn't have one standard of judgment for one person and another standard for someone else. Paul wrote that God "will render to every man according to His deeds: to them who by patient continuance in well doing seek for glory and horor and immortality — eternal life: but unto them that are contentious and do not obey the truth, but obey unrighteousness — indignation and wrath . . . for there is no respecter of persons with God" (Romans 2:6-10).
