A CHRISTIAN'S TRANSFORMATION

Do you know what God thinks about you? As a Christian, God is transforming you into the likeness of Christ (2 Corinthians $3:18 - {}^{18}$ And we all, who with unveiled faces contemplate the Lord's glory, are being transformed into his image with ever-increasing glory, which comes from the Lord, who is the Spirit.). God is pressing His people into a Christshaped mold. You may say, "I don't think God is transforming me into anything!" But brethren, we must remember that God can and will transform anyone and anything according to His mighty will. It doesn't matter where you are in life, God can still bring transformation out of any situation (2 Corinthians $5:17 - {}^{17}$ Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here!). When we received Jesus and were baptized into His church, He didn't just forgive our sins, He changed our nature. Of course, this transformation isn't an easy process, partly because the world is trying to press us into its own mold. In order to be transformed into the image of Christ we must resist being conformed to this world. Paul writes, "² Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is – his good, pleasing, and perfect will" (Romans 12:2).

I think it's important to know who we are and who God thinks we are. Stay with me

here – if what you think God thinks of you is not what God actually thinks of you, then you become what you think God thinks of you instead of what He actually thinks of you. What? That means that what we think about ourselves matters! And it's important to call ourselves what God calls us. We're the "elect." The Greek word for "elect" is "eklektos" meaning to be chosen or selected for God's divine purpose. This word is often translated as "chosen." Matthew records the words of Jesus in the parable of the wedding banquet (Matthew 22:1-14) and concludes in verse 14 with: "¹⁴ For many are invited, but few are <u>cho-</u>

sen" (emphasis mine) (See also Matthew 24:22; 24:24 24:31; Mark 13:20; 13:27; Luke 18:7; 23:25; 1 Peter 2:6; and Romans 8:33 – in each case, at least in the NIV, "eklektos" is translated "Chosen"). God calls us His elect! God has chosen us to be transformed into the image of His son!

So, we're told that our old self has died (Romans 6:8) but as humans, we all still sin and yet, sin was broken by the power of the

cross. Then we're told in 1 John 3:6 that, "⁶ No one who lives in Him keeps on sinning. No one who continues to sin has either seen Him or known Him." That statement then, begs the question of how can this transformation (old to new) be possible? Where does this transformation begin and what makes it possible? Well, I believe it is only possible if it begins in the mind and heart.

Paul says that we are transformed by the renewal of our minds (Romans 12:2). This transformation is an inside-out transformation. Too often we focus on changing our actions, instead of our attitudes. That's exactly what many of the Pharisees did. They were overly concerned with externals while their hearts were deteriorating – fading



toward death. Since they focused solely on external righteousness to the neglect of their hearts, they became like cups that are clean on the outside but filthy inside (Matthew 23:25-9). They were like pretty caskets full of dead people's bones. They looked good on the outside, all polished and shiny with a glorious arrangement of casket flowers adorning the top, but their hearts were hollow.

When Paul wrote to the Christians in Philippi, he realized that their problems with regard to unity were merely symptoms of a deeper problem. Paul addressed the real problem and offered advice to fix the issue in Philippians 2:1-11: "¹

Therefore if you have any encouragement from being united with Christ, if any comfort from His love, if any common sharing in the Spirit, if any tenderness and compassion, 2 then make my joy complete by being likeminded, having the same love, being one in spirit and of one mind.³ Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in humility value others above yourselves, ⁴ not looking to your own interests but each

of you to the interests of the others. ⁵ In your relationships with one another, have the same mindset as Christ Jesus: ⁶ Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be used to his own advantage; ⁷ rather, He made himself nothing by taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness.⁸ And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled himself by becoming obedient to death - even death on a cross! ⁹ Therefore God exalted Him to the highest place and gave Him the name that is above every name, ¹⁰ that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, ¹¹ and every tongue acknowledge that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory [continued on page 6]

of God the Father" (emphasis mine). Transformation begins in the mind and extends to our mannerisms. It begins in the heart and extends to our habits. It begins in our attitudes and extends to our actions. Are your mannerisms, habits and actions showing you how well your transformation is going? Is it showing a transformation, regardless of how fast or slow, of which God would approve? Brethren, we must allow Jesus to live in us as Paul declares in Romans 8:9: "9 You, however, are not in the realm of the flesh but are in the realm of the Spirit, if indeed the Spirit of God lives in you. And if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, they do not belong to Christ." (emphasis mine) (see also 1 Corinthians 6:19; Colossians 1:27; and 1 John 4:15).

Fortunately for us, God's mercy and grace mean we don't get what we deserve. Even so, we are not the temptations we resist, we are the values we embrace. Hebrews 4:15 tells us, "⁵ For we do not have a High Priest who is unable to empathize with our weaknesses, but we have One who has been tempted in every way, just as we are – yet He did not sin." It isn't sin to be tempted – noble character doesn't mean we're not tempted – it means we choose our values over our temptations and every time we do so, our transformation takes us closer to the ideal – Jesus Christ.

¹ Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God – this is your true and proper worship. – Romans 12:1

Psalm 19:13-14 – ¹³Keep back Your servant also from presumptuous sins; let them not have dominion over me. Then I shall be blameless, and I shall be innocent of great transgression. ¹⁴ Let the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be acceptable in Your sight, O Lord, my strength and my Redeemer.
