



This is common thinking in our world today. But Paul has a completely different idea about the character of God (Paul was one of the main writers of the New Testament for those who might believe that, as I stated, Jesus was always loving and never judgmental. To understand God's righteousness fully, we need to understand our problem.

<sup>"18</sup> For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who suppress the truth in unrighteousness, <sup>19</sup> because what may be known of God is manifest in them, for God has

shown it to them. <sup>20</sup> For since the creation of the world His invisible attributes are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even His eternal power and Godhead, so that they are without excuse, <sup>21</sup> because, although they knew God, they did not glorify Him as God, nor were thankful, but became futile in their thoughts, and their foolish hearts were darkened. <sup>22</sup> Professing to be wise, they became fools, <sup>23</sup> and changed the glory of the incorruptible God into an image made like corruptible man – and birds and fourfooted animals and creeping things" (Romans 1:18-23).

Modern "seeker" churches have drawn huge crowds by never mentioning sin and judgment, instead focusing on the more positive aspects of the gospel: "God loves you. He offers you an abundant life full of peace, joy and love. He will help you with your problems. He wants you to be happy. Won't you invite Him into your heart?" But these same churches never seem to get around to mentioning that there is a God who is justified in His wrath against sinners. We've all bought into the liberal message that theologian Richard Niebur once described as, "A God without wrath [who] brought men without sin into a kingdom without judgment through the ministrations of a Christ without a Cross."


When Paul begins to expound on the gospel that he had proclaimed, interestingly, he doesn't lead off with the love of God. He begins with the righteousness of God and as he expounds further he still doesn't mention God's love - he mentions God's wrath. Modern critics

> would say, "Paul, you're not going to win any converts by that approach! Lighten up! Maybe, much later, you can touch on that subject. But when you're trying to win people to Christ, don't mention God's wrath!" If we're going to understand

why we need God's power in the gospel and why we need His very righteousness imputed to our account, we need to understand His wrath against our sin.

If we're not such bad folks and if we have enough good deeds to earn points towards heaven, then we wouldn't need Gods righteousness and Christ did not need to bear God's wrath on our behalf. But, we are ungodly and unrighteous in God's sight, if we have suppressed the truth in unrighteousness, and as a result are under His just wrath, then we desperately need God's saving power through the gospel!

In the verses prior to our main text (16-17), Paul told us that God's righteousness has been revealed through the gospel, the good news of Jesus being ruler over all things. But in revealing that God is faithful to His word to save those who are righteous, there is another side to that coin. If God is faithful to His word, then the message of Habakkuk has another, important point: God's righteousness condemns the wicked. The righteous live by faith. The wicked do not. If God is faithful to keep His word and has promised to deliver the righteous, save the righteous and vindicate the righteous, then by necessity God is

faithful to judge all ungodliness and all unrighteousness. The gospel, which reveals Jesus as the deliverer from sins, also reveals Jesus as judge of those who never accept his deliverance. God's wrath has been revealed. God has kept His word and His covenant; we have not. God has been just, fair and right; we have not.

Paul's point is that all people are without excuse. It's not that most people are under the power of sin, but that all people are - no one gets a pass. God has revealed Himself in the creation. Sin is the rejection of God as God. It is the transgressing of God's law. In looking about and seeing God's invisible attributes in the creation, people are expected to seek after God. We should be motivated to learn about God, to know His will, to worship Him. But humans have refused to honor God, worship God, praise God, give Him our thanks. The appropriate response should have been glorifying God and instead we have turned to foolishness. We have turned to created, physical things. Our thinking and our hearts have become warped and damaged because we are not worshiping God as we ought.

Instead of worshiping God as we should, we are foolish and have turned to the worship of our jobs, families, possessions, bank accounts and ourselves and our desires — in short anything that takes our attention away from God. Jeremiah lamented in 2:11 of his book, "Has a nation changed its gods, which are not gods? But My people have changed their Glory for what does not profit."

God's wrath has been revealed. It is real and stands against our unrighteousness. God's righteousness demands that He be just and execute justice. Sin is the rejection of God as God. We cannot refuse to honor God or give Him thanks – worship is the only acceptable response before Him. Brethren, let none of us exchange the glory of the immortal God for false gods, whatever they may be.

#### SELECTED VERSES FROM ACTS

Acts 16:11-15 - <sup>11</sup>Therefore, sailing from Troas, we ran a straight course to Samothrace, and the next day came to Neapolis, <sup>12</sup> and from there to Philippi, which is the foremost city of that part of Macedonia, a colony. And we were staving in that city for some days. <sup>13</sup>And on the Sabbath day we went out of the city to the riverside, where prayer was customarily made; and we sat down and spoke to the women who met there. <sup>14</sup>Now a certain woman named Lydia heard us. She was a seller of purple from the city of Thyatira, who worshiped God. The Lord opened her heart to heed the things spoken by Paul. <sup>15</sup>And when she and her household were baptized, she begged us, saying, "If you have judged me to be faithful to the Lord, come to my house and stay." So she persuaded us.

**Romans 1:16-17** – <sup>16</sup> For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes, for the Jew first and also for the Greek. <sup>17</sup> For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith to faith; as it is written, "The just shall live by faith."
